

# Funded Grantham Institute PhD internships with startups working with algae

The <u>Grantham Institute</u> will be funding three paid internships focused on algae research, due to a generous donation for work in this area. The work will be with one of the companies that completed <u>The Greenhouse</u> accelerator programme, based at <u>Undaunted</u>.

There are five positions being advertised, of which three will be filled. The successful candidates will get paid £28.02 per hour, including holiday pay. They will be set up via the Imperial casual worker process.

### **Eligibility**

The internships will be offered by start-ups in the Undaunted ecosystem. They will be up to three months long and open to postgraduate students registered for a PhD at Imperial College London. Due to visa restrictions, these will not be open to international students on a Tier 4 visas. Candidates will need approval from their PhD supervisor to take an interruption of studies and undertake one of these internships.

#### **Timeline**

- w/c 22 September: internship projects shared across the Imperial PhD network
- 12 October: deadline for interested students to apply directly to companies.
  Companies to shortlist and interview candidates
- w/c 27 October: companies to advise the Grantham Institute on their preferred candidate

- w/c 3 November: Grantham Institute to confirm offers. Successful candidates to submit a supervisor approval form to the Grantham Institute. Casual worker set-up process to commence.
- w/c 17 November: students can commence placement. This is flexible and to be decided in consultation with the company.
- At the end of the placement, a short report for the funder will be requested.

#### Background

The Grantham Institute – Climate Change and the Environment is a hub for climate and environment research at Imperial, bringing together researchers from across the College to work towards a vision for a sustainable, resilient, zero-carbon society.

<u>Undaunted</u>, a partnership between the Grantham Institute and the Ri, is building a community of multi-disciplinary innovators focused on turning ideas into impact. It does this through a number of programmes for innovators at different stages, such as <u>Climate</u> <u>Solutions Catalyst</u>, <u>The Greenhouse</u> and <u>EarthScale</u>.
